YouLead Global Youth Leadership Program's goal is to connect, cultivate, inspire and empower high school Juniors and Seniors throughout the DFW area to make a positive contribution to their communities and sphere of influence. The communities these young leaders impact include not only their local communities but can, and often times do, expand worldwide. There are many youth programs in the area; these programs, however, tend to target kids in a specific city or with a certain ethnic background. **YouLead** GYL is unique in that we strive to be inclusive regardless of the student's economic or ethnic background. Through collaborations with various community and business leaders and other diverse organizations, students are given innovative, hands-on experiences through workshops, informative speaking events, exclusive site visits, and participation in community service projects. In essence, we will use the community as a classroom. Eligibility – Applicants must:

- Be a current **High School Junior or Senior (2018-2019)** with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Demonstrate leadership potential in their school and/or community.
- Have an interest in furthering their knowledge about our world and community leadership.
- Receive approval by parents / guardian.
- Commit to full participation in the program, including writing a reflection essay, completing a community project, & have timely responses to emails. There is a mandatory Orientation and Retreat on Saturday, August 11, 2018 (no exceptions).

Student Commitments:

- Students are responsible for transportation to and from sessions.
- Attend monthly sessions / August through March, 9:00 am 4:00 pm / **Third Saturday** of the month.
 - Exceptions:
 - Opening Retreat will be held on Saturday, August 11th, 2018.
- Attendance at all sessions is expected. Two or more unexcused absences will result in removal from the program. Being accepted in *YouLead* GYL is similar to signing a contract. Both sides have obligations. You will agree to contribute your presence, ideas and energy, and we agree to challenge you and expose you to new ideas.
- Mandatory Orientation and Retreat on Saturday, August 11th, 2018.

 provide thoughtful responses to the application questions.

 Decisions will be based upon information obtained from the application. The selection committee will be looking for a diverse group of students to provide the richest experience possible for participants. At least one student from each school that submits an application will be chosen.
- All applicants will be notified of the status of their application by June 22nd, 2018.
