Eligibility – Applicants must:

- Be a current High School Junior or Senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Demonstrate leadership potential in school and/or community.
- Have an interest in furthering their knowledge about our world and community leadership.
- Receive approval by parents / guardian.
- Commit to full participation in the program, including writing reflection essays, completing a community project, & have timely responses to emails and messages. There is a mandatory Orientation and Retreat that participants MUST ATTEND with no exceptions.

Student Commitments:

- Students are responsible for transportation to and from sessions.
- Attend monthly sessions / January through June 2023, 1pm 5:00 pm / First Saturday of the month. There will be a few exceptions.
- Attendance at all sessions is expected. Two or more unexcused absences will result in removal from the program. Being accepted in YouLead GYL is similar to signing a contract. Both sides have obligations. You will agree to contribute your presence, ideas and energy, and we agree to challenge you and expose you to new ideas.
